The work of the Holy Spirit is to carry out God's will and purpose for your life and to help you understand the word of God, to help you see those things that the Spirit of God has brought into your life, to help you know God, and to bring you the presence of God. And [then] to enable you with the power of the Spirit to do great things for God, to become a witness [an effective witness] for Jesus Christ. So, all of that is the work of the Holy Spirit.

Some people ask this question, 'And how do you know when the Holy Spirit has left you?" The Holy Spirit will not leave you, except you leave God! You will have to go into apostasy for the Holy Spirit to leave you. That means you will have to completely reject Jesus Christ before the Holy Spirit could leave you. So, He will not leave you except you totally reject Jesus Christ, and no Christian would reject Jesus Christ. As long as you're a Christian, you have not rejected Jesus Christ; the Holy Spirit will not leave you.

Now, in St. John's gospel chapter 14, when you read from verse 16, "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever." So, the Holy Spirit has come to abide with you forever! [Continues verse 17] "Even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him, but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you and shall be in you." [John 14:16-17]

So, He's come to abide with you forever; the Holy Spirit will not leave you. In St. Matthew's gospel, chapter 28, when you read verse 20, He says, "...lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the age." [Matthew 28:20] So, He's with you by the Holy Spirit [through the Holy Spirit]. And then, also, in Ephesians chapter 1 from verse 13, He says, "In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory." [Ephesians 1:13-14].

So, the Holy Spirit is the earnest [the deposit] of the purchased possession. He is the earnest, the deposit, the down payment; that's what it means. So, since the Holy Spirit has been given as the down payment until the completeness (the completion, the final consummation) of the eternal salvation; when all that God planned in Christ is brought to pass, when everything is completed—that's the end of the age—it says the Holy Spirit remains with us; so, the Holy Spirit will not leave you.

POWERED BY THE HOLY GHOST

Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts (Zechariah 4:6).

You have what it takes to win, irrespective of the adversities you may face in life. If you've found yourself in a precarious situation, be comforted; there's someone living inside you, who is greater and stronger than Satan, the world, and all the troubles, elements, and circumstances of this world—the Holy Spirit. You're powered by the Holy Spirit. No wonder John said, "Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4). Become ever more conscious of the Spirit—His power, glory, and ministry in your life.

Even in prayer, you must rely on Him to pray effectively. Some people pray, but nothing happens, because they speak words that aren't powered, communicated or inspired by the Holy Spirit. The power of the Holy Spirit is the missing element in many people's lives; it explains why they live as victims whereas God has made them victors. In Ephesians 5:18-19, the Apostle Paul tells us, "And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." Being filled with the Spirit is the answer. When you're filled with the Spirit, you'll bring the supernatural power of God to bear on your words and all you do.

The Holy Spirit makes the difference; He's the power of God and He lives in you in His fullness; in His entire glory and might. How then could your life be ordinary? In the book of Acts, the apostles understood this and ministered always in and by the power of the Spirit. Oftentimes, they were described as men full of the Holy Ghost; for example, Stephen (Acts 6:5). Then it says in verse 8, "And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people." The same can, and should be said of you; you're full of the Holy Ghost and power because Acts 1:8 says, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...." You can have extraordinary results in your life and ministry because you're powered by the Holy Ghost. Hallelujah!
