Each of you must take responsibility for doing the creative best you can with your own life (Galatians 6:5 MSG).

Some Christians try to make God responsible for what actually is their responsibility. Often times, when something unpleasant happens, they'd conclude, "It's the will of God; otherwise, why did He let it happen?" What such people need to realise is that the authority to change things on earth, and make our lives as beautiful as we desire, has been given to us. You can make your life glorious by living out God's Word.

In Matthew 17:20, the Lord Jesus was emphatic when He said, "...verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you." He makes it clear that you can create your victorious life by acting your faith on the Word of God. He already gave you the measure of faith you require to effect the changes you desire.

In Mark 9:23, He said, "...all things are possible to him that believeth." The question is, do you believe? If you do, then you have before you a life of endless possibilities. Put the Word to work in your life, and you'll always be victorious. Don't "wait" for His Word to come to pass in your life; rather, you're to work the Word. Philippians 2:12 says, "...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." Work out the Word in your life and make it produce results. Using your faith, you can be what you want to be, change what you want to change, and achieve whatever you want to achieve! Faith is our currency and "power to do" in the Kingdom of God.

God has already given you the dominion and the authority to create your triumphant life, by altering the course of events in your life to conform with His perfect will. Keep living in the Word, and the glory of God will be manifest in all you do. Remain blessed in the Lord!

THE HOLY SPIRIT DOES THE WORK

Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works (John 14:10).

The Lord Jesus, in the verse above, referred to the Holy Spirit as the Father that dwells in Him. He's the "doer" of the works. Yes, we don't see the Holy Spirit, and we can't touch or relate with Him through our senses, but His presence, impact and ministry in, through and for us is so real and profound.

The Holy Spirit is God; the Holy Spirit is the voice of God. The Holy Spirit is the extension of God. Sometimes, even when He ministers to us, we don't realize He's the one. For example, in Matthew 16:13-17 when Jesus asked His disciples, "Whom do men say that I am?" In answering, they weren't sure; but Peter said, "You're the Christ, the son of the living God." The Lord's response to Peter was, "Simon, flesh and blood didn't reveal this to you, but my Father who is in heaven." It takes a revelation to know who Jesus is, and that revelation is granted by God. Peter didn't know it was a knowledge from God that was granted him.

The Gospel we're commissioned to take to the nations of the world is something that can't be humanly devised, accepted, and understood. There's no way for an ordinary man to accept it. The Bible says, "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God" (1 Corinthians 1:18). We need help from the ministry of the Holy Spirit for others to accept the Gospel just as we had to be helped to accept it. Psalm 127:1 says, "Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it...." We all must be conscious of this as soul winners.

If you're trying to build the Church of God without the Holy Spirit, it's not going to work. He's the Lord of the harvest. He does the work. Read the inspiring and life-transforming words of the Lord Jesus in John 16:7-8 AMPC: "However, I am telling you nothing but the truth when I say it is profitable (good, expedient, advantageous) for you that I go away. Because if I do not go away, the Comforter (Counsellor, HELPER, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengthener, Standby) will not come to you...And when He comes, He will convict and convince the world and bring demonstration to it about sin and about righteousness (uprightness of heart and right standing with God) and about judgment." Hallelujah!
