## Prayer for the Week

## WORKING THE WORD Romans 10:10

*For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation (Romans 10:10).*

There're three vital things you must do to effectively work the Word and enjoy God's provisions for you always. First, your heart must line up with the Word. The Bible says, *"For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness..." (Romans 10:10)*. That means you're made right with God when you come into agreement with His Word in your heart.

The second thing is, your mind must line up with your heart on the Word. This implies that the Word must have meaning in your understanding. Without that meaning, you can't communicate what's in your heart through language.

Then, third, you must speak the Word—"rhema" (Greek); a word directed to a specific person, at a specific time, for a specific purpose. It's the active Word given for a particular situation. That was what Ezekiel uttered in the valley of dry bones; he said, *"I prophesied as He (the Lord) commanded me"* (Ezekiel 37:10).

If your speech or utterance isn't in line or agreement with what God has said, you'll get the wrong result. The opening text says, *"For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation"* (Romans 10:10). The word translated "confession is made" is the Greek word "homologeō," which means to speak in consent, or in agreement with another.

The inspiration of the Spirit provides us with God's Word (rhema). Our meditation on this word or declaration of it produces tremendous results, bringing the Word into manifestation.

## UNVEILING THE CHRIST LIFE IN YOU

*To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory (Colossians 1:27).*

Christianity is the outworking of the Word of God in a human person. As a Christian, you're essentially the image of Christ; every step you take should be the expression of the divine life in you. That's how Jesus lived when He walked the earth. He was the manifestation of God: the expression of the divine life.

You're Christ alive to your world, your family, workplace, neighbourhood, city, and country; in that place where you are—you're the Christ that they see. Therefore, your words and actions, the life you live, the way you do the things you do, should express the Christ-nature in you.

When people look at you, they should see the glory of the new creation. You're a God-carrying vessel; carry this consciousness with you today; this is God's dream for your life. True success is God manifesting and expressing Himself in, and through you; it's how much His personality and character are revealed through you. Your goal, therefore, should be to always reveal Him.

Everything you do should be about one thing only: the manifestation of the Christ-life in you; His perfection and righteousness expressed through you. Hallelujah!

Don't ignore that which God has put in you. Does He give you more power? No! He's already given you all the power you could ever need—Himself! He's power personified. You're the one to work His power in you to its maximum. The Bible says, *"And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all"* (Acts 4:33).

From where did they get great power? Jesus didn't say, *"You shall receive great power"; He said, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you..." (Acts 1:8)*. They got all the power they needed from the power-giver inside them. They activated that power for whatever they needed. So, recognise and put the power in you to work.
