GOING TO THE PROMISE LAND

- 1. God wants you to terminate everything that is keeping away the glory of God in your life.** **Romans 6:1** says; *“What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Sin is anything you do that does not glorify God Almighty. Therefore, you have to terminate it. The book of **Leviticus 11:44-45** says; *“For I am the Lord your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves and you shall be holy for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth. For I am the Lord who brings you out of the land of Egypt to be your God. You shall therefore be holy for I am holy.”* God is a holy God. The bible verse of **Matthew 5:48** says; *“Therefore, you shall be perfect just as your Father in heaven is perfect.”* Everything that is keeping back the glory of God in you must be terminated in Jesus Name, Amen.*
- 2. God wants you to terminate every spirit of procrastination.** It is not good for you to stay on a particular level on your job for too long without promotion, you postpone what you are supposed to do today for tomorrow or in future, putting aside academic advancement that would have Skyrocketed you to an enviable position. **Deuteronomy 1:6** says; *“The Lord our God spoke to us in Horeb saying you have dwelt long enough at this mountain.”* **Deuteronomy 2:2-3** says; *“And the Lord spoke to me saying; “You have skirted this mountain long enough; turn northward.””* **...to be continued.**

.....Remain blessed in the Lord!

SET YOUR MIND ON SPIRITUAL THINGS

Set your **AFFECTION** on things above, not on things on the earth (**Colossians 3:2**).

Even though “affection” is quite a good and strong rendering in the verse above, the Greek word, “phroneo” is a little more practical. It means to set your mind or your thinking; an activity of the mind; how your mind works. It originates from two words; one meaning, “To reign in,” like you say, “I’ve got to reign this fellow in”; that is, to bring him under control. The second word means, “To block in or fence in.”

Thus, the admonition to set your affection on things above means to have control on your mind and consciously set your thinking on spiritual things. Remember that the things you think about are the things that will control your actions.

For example, you may have been wrestling with certain habits; habits that affect the way you serve and live for the Lord; habits that reduce your effectiveness and efficiency. You might have prayed about it, yet, nothing seemed to have changed. It's not so much about prayer as it's about the use of your mind! Your mind is a very powerful machine; you can twist or control it any way you choose. So, what you must do is to first, consciously refuse to think on those things you know aren't wholesome, and deliberately focus your mind on the Word.

Practise exercising your mind through conscious thought. If, for whatever reason, an unwholesome thought comes to you, say, “No,” and then, switch your mind to something excellent; to the Word. Don't be surprised if such thoughts creep in again; resist it and repeat the process. **James 4:7** says *“...Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”* God knows what's in the devil, and He tells us if we resist him, he'll flee; that's got to be the necessary result!
