POWER OF CONTINUITY Psalm 50:15-21

Continued from two week ago....

Do not condemn anyone because no one is righteous. **Isaiah 54:6** says; *“For the Lord has called you like a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, like a youthful wife when you were refused.”* Because of your calling, persecution is in the package and disappointment is always there. Enemies want you to cry; they want you to be uprooted but with God, nobody can destabilize you. For every evil work against you, God meant it for good. Every evil works of the enemy against you is cancelled in Jesus Name.

One of the problems in African countries is lack of continuity. The government does not want to continue with the programmes of the past administration because they want something new. Generally, Africans have their culture which is to be respectful and obedient. They extend this respectfulness to strangers. They honour their Parents and elders. However, when Africans move to other countries, they forget their own culture and imbibe foreign culture, character, attitude that are alien to them. The will of God is for you to continue with the good things you are doing; serve the Lord and worship Him in order to fulfil His purpose in your life.

ACHIEVING POWER OF CONTINUITY

CHARACTER: You should have a good character. Some people have good characters but no anointing. Anointing will do the work and character will enable you to do the work. It is character that brought Joseph to Egypt while the anointing manifested. His brothers hated him but he did not curse them. His character did not change when his brothers visited him in Egypt. They were of the same father but different mothers except Benjamin. Joseph wanted the relationship to continue. He forgave them, gave them food, and gave them good things (putting a coal of fire upon them). God favoured him in the land of Egypt.

If God makes you a lifter, you will encounter disappointments. Abraham lifted Lot but Lot disappointed Abraham by choosing the best vegetation instead of allowing his uncle to choose first. Jesus lifted Judas but he betrayed Him. Jesus lifted Peter who was an ordinary fisherman but he denied Him. Jesus lifted Thomas but he doubted the resurrection of Jesus. (All disappointments).

People may have disappointed you but God never disappoints....

ADOPT THE PRAISE STRATEGY

And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city (Joshua 6:16).

In the verse above, we observe a strategy of the Spirit given to the children of Israel to take over Jericho. The strategy was very specific. There was a time when the victory strategy was for Moses' hands to be up, for them to defeat Amalek. But this time, it was different. God told them to go round the city of Jericho six days, once every day. On the seventh day, they were to do it seven times, and by the seventh time, they were to shout, and the walls of Jericho would fall down flat (Joshua 6:3-5).

What a strategy! There're times when all God would probably have you do is to praise Him. At such times, He's not expecting you to start binding and casting out devils; yet, as you praise Him, the forces of darkness will flee! Circumstances will begin to align themselves with God's plan for your life! The Bible says, *“Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand” (Psalm 149:6).* Imagine Paul and Silas locked up in prison. It was a precarious situation. Nevertheless, at midnight, at the darkest hour of neglect; at that time when the pain and reality of their incarceration should be too much to bear, rather than become angry at God for “forsaking” them, they adopted the praises unto God, until there was a supernatural jailbreak! An earthquake erupted that shook the prison to its foundations, flinging the prison doors wide open and both men came out (Acts 16:23-26).

Where are you in your life today? What situation are you facing that seems insurmountable? Don't give up. Don't call a pity-party. Don't feel alone and forsaken; adopt the praise strategy. Praise God profusely from your spirit, not in anticipation of victory, but in victory. Praise Him, knowing that He always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of His knowledge by us in every place (2 Corinthians 2:14).
