THE MERCYFUL GOD ZECHARIAH 10:11

God is speaking to everyone, *He said "ask for rain in the time of the latter rain" - Zechariah 10:1.* The time of the raining season is coming to an end. Do not ask for rain in the time of raining season so that you will not say it is normal but ask in the time the raining season has almost ended so that you can see the power of God. Rain is a symbol of blessing.

God is a God of mercy; He said "ask for rain in the time of the latter rain", when everything is over, when it seems that nothing is happening, God wants you to ask and He is going to bring rain into your life. In the time of Elijah when there was no rain on earth for three and half years, Elijah said to Ahab *"Go up eat and drink for there is the sound of abundance of rain"*, (1Kings 18:41). For His mercy endures forever"*, **Psalm 102:13** says; *"You will arise and have mercy on Zion; For the time to favour her, Yes, the set time, has come."* Through the mercy of God, we have forgiveness, joy and God brings us back to Himself even after we have gone astray. The Lord determined to destroy the whole world because He was sorry He created the world.

According to **Genesis 6:6-8**; *"And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. So the Lord said; "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."* But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord." Noah found grace before God, He found unmerited favour. When we talk about grace, we talk about mercy. **Matthew 9:13** says; *"But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."* When the mercy of God comes upon you, there is no sacrifice anymore, He is a merciful God, and He will have mercy upon you today....**to be continued.**
